

Law 2-139."


AUTHORIZATION

Pursuant to Sections 502(a) and 1716(b) of the District of Columbia Merit Personnel Act of 1978, (D.C. Code Sections 1-605.2 and 1-618.16) the Public Employee Relations Board (PERB or Board) determines that the unit found appropriate for non-compensation bargaining as described in the "Certification of Representative" in PERB Case No. 94-R-02 shall be included in the following unit for the purpose of compensation bargaining:

UNIT 1 - consisting of all career service professional, technical, administrative and clerical employees who currently have their compensation set in accordance with the District Service (D.S.) Schedule and who come within the personnel authority of the Mayor of the District of Columbia, the Board of Trustees of the University of the District of Columbia and District of Columbia Board of Library Trustees, except physicians employed by the Department of Human Services and Department of Corrections and registered nurses employed by the Department of Human Services.
