The Petitioner filed an Amended Recognition Petition with the District of Columbia Public Employee Relations Board (the Board) on October 8, 1981 requesting "...to change the name of the Petitioner in this case from Local 12, AFGE, to Local 1000, AFGE" due to internal changes within the American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE). The purpose of the request is to facilitate a transfer of jurisdiction for the District of Columbia Department of Employment Services (DOES) employees to a local comprised exclusively of DOES employees. AFGE, in its Amended Petition, complied with the provisions of Board Rule 101.3 by filing with the Board a list of Local 1000's officers and representatives, a copy of its Constitution and By-Laws and a Statement of Objectives.

Objections to the Petitioner's request were not entered by the Agency and were withdrawn by the Intervenor.

ORDER

It is ordered that:

Petitioner's name herein be changed from Local 12, American

Federation of Government Employees to Local 1000, American Federation of Government Employees.
