



PETITION FOR CLARIFICATION

1. Effective October 1, 1977, D.C. General Hospital is no longer an organization of the D.C. Department of Human Resources. Therefore, clarification of the existing unit covered by the Licensed Practical Nurses' Association of the District of Columbia is necessary.
2. The existing unit is: All licensed practical nurses employed at the District of Columbia General Hospital, Department of Human Resources, excluding management executives, confidential employees, supervisors, and employees engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity.
3. Clarification of the existing unit would include: All licensed practical nurses employed at D.C. General Hospital, excluding management executives, confidential employees, supervisors, and employees engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity.
4. The D.C. Department of Human Resources has consulted with the Licensed Practical Nurses' Association of the District of Columbia regarding clarification of the existing unit. The labor organization expressed no opposition to this clarification.
5. This petition is merely for clarification of the unit covered by the Licensed Practical Nurses' Association of the District of Columbia; there is no change in the contract agreement between the two parties.
