CERTIFICATION OF ELECTION RESULTS

I. Statement of the Case

The results of an election in the above-captioned proceeding have been duly reported to the parties on December 2, 2025, as follows: pursuant to the Decision and Order of the Public Employee Relations Board (PERB) in Opinion No. 1929, an in-person secret ballot election was conducted for the following unit:

Career Service employees in the Contract Specialist DS-12 position, Contract Specialist DS-13 position, Contract Specialist DS-14 position, and the Program Support Specialist DS-11 position within the Department of General Services – Contracts and Procurement Division; excluding all management officials, supervisors, confidential employees, employees engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity and employees engaged in administering the provisions of Title XVII of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, D.C. Law 2-139.

The in-person election was conducted by PERB staff on December 2, 2025. Approximately ten (10) employees were eligible to vote.¹ A notice of election (Notice) was posted on September 12,

2024. Eligible employees received one (1) ballot, for choice of representative. Immediately after the end of the election on December 2, 2025, PERB staff conducted the ballot tally in the presence of both parties' election observers and determined the outcome of the election based on the majority of the valid votes cast.

The ballot for choice of representative stated: "For the purposes of exclusive recognition under the Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, who do you wish to be represented by?" and offered a choice of AFGE or No Union. Twelve (12) DGS employees cast ballots on choice of representative. Two (2) ballots were challenged.

The results are hereby reported as follows:

American Federation of Government Employees (AFGE)	10	votes
No Union	0	votes
Challenged Ballots	2	votes
Spoiled Ballots	0	votes
Void Ballots	0	votes

Pursuant to Board Rule 515.2, "no later than seven (7) days after the tally of ballots has been served, any party to the election proceeding may file with the Board objections to the election procedure or to any conduct that might have improperly affected the results of the election." The Board did not receive any objections from the parties regarding the election.

Having received no objections concerning the conduct of the above-described election proceeding, pursuant to Board Rule 515.5, the results of the election, as reported, are hereby certified.
