ORDER¹

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Complainants' Motion for Preliminary Relief is denied.
2. The Board's Executive Director shall refer the standards of conduct complaint to a Hearing Examiner and schedule a hearing under the expedited schedule set forth below.
3. Since PERB Case Nos. 07-S-02, 07-U-25 and 07-S-01 involve common issues, we are consolidating these cases.
4. A hearing shall be scheduled in the consolidated cases before July 15, 2007. The Notice of Hearing shall be issued seven (7) days prior to the date of the hearing.

¹Since this matter concerns a Motion for Preliminary Relief, the Board has decided to issue its Order now. A decision will follow.

5. Following the hearing, the designated Hearing Examiner shall submit a Report and Recommendation to the Board no later than twenty-one (21) days following the conclusion of closing arguments or the submission of post-hearing briefs.
6. Parties may file exceptions and briefs in support of the exceptions no later than seven (7) days after service of the Hearing Examiner's Report and Recommendation. A response or opposition to the exceptions may be filed no later than five (5) days after service of the exceptions.


