
Unit Description:

energy conserv. analysts, mechanical engineers, engineering technicians, facilities operation managers, locksmiths, logistics management specialists, management and program analysts, staff assistants, statisticians, summer residents, transportation operations specialists, excluding all management officials, supervisors, confidential employees, employees engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity and employees engaged in administering the provisions of Title XVII of the District of Columbia Personnel Act of 1978, D.C. Law 2-139.


