ORDER

Complaints were filed by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, District Council 20, Local 2290 (AFSCME) on January 17, 1990 (PERB Case No. 90-U-07), and on February 8, 1990 (PERB Case No. 90-U-09), alleging that violations of D.C. Code 1-618.4 (a)(1) and (2) (PERB Case No. 90-U-07 and D.C. Code 1-618.6 (a)(1) and (2) and 1-618.4 (a), (1), (2) and (3) (PERB Case No. 90-U-09) were committed by the Washington Convention Center. By letter dated June 18, 1990, the Board has been advised that the parties are pursuing a settlement of these matters. AFSCME's request that the Board hold these matters in abeyance pending settlement efforts was not opposed by the Washington Convention Center. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

The Board will hold these matters in abeyance pending the outcome of the parties' settlement negotiations. Cf. Local 2087, District Council 20 AFSCME and University of the District of Columbia, Opinion No. 10, PERB Case No. 87-R-17 (July 12, 1989).
