DECISION AND ORDER

Psychologists Union Local 3758, 1199 (NUHHCE) National Union of Hospital and Health Care Employees, AFL-CIO (“Complainant”) filed the instant unfair labor practice complaint against the District of Columbia Department of Mental Health (“Respondent”) alleging that the Respondent had not provided responses to requests for information related to an arbitration. Counsel for Complainant has advised the Executive Director that the arbitration and all appeals therefrom are concluded in the Complainant’s favor and that this unfair labor practice complaint is moot. Accordingly, the complaint is dismissed.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Unfair Labor Practice Complaint is dismissed as moot.
2. Pursuant to Board Rule 559.2, this Decision and Order is final upon issuance.




