CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

An election having been conducted in the above-referenced case by the U.S. Department of Labor, Division of Public Employee Labor Relations under the supervision of the Executive Director of the D.C. Board of Labor Relations, it is indicated from the Tabulation of the results that the professional (i.e., non-faculty) employees and the faculty employees have voted for inclusion in a single unit and a collective bargaining representative has been selected by a majority of the valid votes cast. Furthermore, no objection was filed to the Tally of Ballots, no objection was filed concerning the conduct of the election, and the number of challenged ballots was insufficient to effect the results of the election.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the District of Columbia Board of Labor Relations by the Board of Higher Education Resolution No. 75-3, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Federal City College Faculty Association/National Education Association is the exclusive representative for a unit of:

All faculty employees, senior skills specialists and skills specialists in the Office of Freshman Advising and Orientation, faculty employees included in the budget of the District of Columbia Teachers College but whose place of work is Federal City College; excluding all management officials, confidential employees, supervisors or any employee engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity.
