Pursuant to a joint Clarification Petition filed by the parties, a representation proceeding has been conducted in the above matter by the District of Columbia Public Employee Relations Board (Board) in accordance with the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978 (CMPA) and the Interim Rules of the Board and it appearing that an exclusive representative has been designated;

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by Section 502(a) and 1710(b)(1) of the CMPA (District of Columbia Code 1-604.2(1), (2) and 1.618.10(b)(1)) and the Interim Rules of the Board Sections 102.1, 102.3 and 101.10.

IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED THAT:


The American Federation of Government Employees, Local 872 (AFGE) has been designated by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their preference for exclusive representative for the purpose of terms-and-conditions bargaining with the employer.

UNIT: "All unrepresented District Service (DS) and Wage and Grade (WG) employees employed in the District of Columbia Department of Public Works (DPW) who were previously assigned to bargaining units within DPW which were exclusively represented by AFGE Locals 631, 872, 2553 and 1975 on July 23, 1984 and

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DS and WG employees in the DPW Bureau of Water Measurement and Billing excluding management officials, supervisors, confidential employees, employees engaged in personnel work in other than purely clerical capacities and employees engaged in administering the provisions of Title XVII of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978."
