ORDER ON REMAND

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This case is before us in remand from the Superior Court of the District of Columbia (Superior Court). Clarence Mack, et al. vs. Fraternal Order of Police/Department of Corrections Labor Committee and Calton Butler, Teretha Spain, Jack Rosser, Carissa Pittman, and Helen Barnett, Civil Div., Case No. 0003891-97 (J. Braman) (1998). On January 23, 1998, we issued a Decision and Order in the above-captioned case, i.e., Slip Op. No. 534, granting the Complainants' Motion for Enforcement of our Order in PERB Case No. 97-S-01, Slip Opinion No. 516.

Upon a Motion filed by the Respondent Fraternal Order of Police/Department of Corrections Labor Committee (FOP) and Clarence Mack, Chairperson of FOP, and consent of the Board, the Superior Court vacated Slip Opinion No. 534 for mootness and remanded the matter to us with instructions to issue an Order vacating the Opinion. Therefore, consistent with the Superior Court's Order, it is hereby ordered that Slip Op. No. 534 is vacated as moot in view of our Decision and Order in Clarence
