ORDER¹

The Board, having considered the "Joint Compensation Unit Determination Petition" filed by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, D.C. Council 20, Local 2401, ("AFSCME, Local 2401") and the Office of Labor Relations and Collective Bargaining (on behalf of the District of Columbia Office of Human Rights, hereby determines that the appropriate compensation unit for all professional employees employed by the District of Columbia Office of Human Rights², is Compensation Unit 1.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The "Joint Compensation Unit Determination Petition" filed by AFSCME, Local 2401 and the Office of Labor Relations and Collective Bargaining (on behalf of the District of Columbia Office of Human Rights), is granted.
2. All non-professional employees employed by the District of Columbia Office of Human Rights are placed in Compensation Unit 1.


