ORDER¹

The Board, having considered the “Joint Compensation Unit Determination Petition” filed by the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, D.C. Council 20, Local 2401, (“AFSCME, Local 2401”) and the Office of Labor Relations and Collective Bargaining (on behalf of the District of Columbia Office of Risk Management), hereby determines that the appropriate compensation unit for all professional and non-professional employees employed by the District of Columbia Office of Risk Management², is Compensation Unit 1.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The “Joint Compensation Unit Determination Petition” filed by AFSCME, Local 2401 and the Office of Labor Relations and Collective Bargaining (on behalf of the District of Columbia Office of Risk Management), is granted.
2. All professional and non-professional employees employed by the District of Columbia Office of Risk Management are placed in Compensation Unit 1.

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
