ORDER

In view of the time sensitive posture of this case, the Board has decided to issue its Order now. A decision will follow. The Board, having considered NUHHCE's "Petition for a Compensation Unit Determination", hereby determines that the appropriate compensation unit for the physician assistants (medicolegal investigators) employed by the District of Columbia Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, is Compensation Unit 1.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The 1199 Metropolitan District, D.C., National Union of Hospital and Health Care Employees' (NUHHCE) Petition for a Compensation Unit Determination is granted.
2. The physician assistants (medicolegal investigators) employed by the District of Columbia Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, are placed in Compensation Unit 1.
