DECISION AND ORDER

Local 631, American Federation of Government Employees (hereafter, AFGE) filed a Recognition Petition with the District of Columbia Public Employee Relations Board (hereafter, Board) requesting representation of a unit of employees of the District of Columbia Office of the Surveyor (hereafter, Agency), described as follows:

"All non-supervisory employees of the Office of the Surveyor, Government of the District of Columbia, excluding management executives, confidential employees, supervisory, or any employees engaged in personnel work in other than a purely clerical capacity".

On November 5, 1981, prior to any final Board action, AFGE withdrew its Petition for Recognition. No objections have been raised against the withdrawal request. The Board has no basis for denying the request.

ORDER

It is ORDERED that:

The request for withdrawal is hereby granted.
