CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

Pursuant to Board Rule 102.2 and the authority vested in me by the District of Columbia Public Employee Relations Board, I have considered the joint request of the Washington Teachers' Union and the District of Columbia Board of Education that exclusive recognition be granted to the Washington Teachers' Union, without an election, to represent the proposed unit of employees pursuant to Board Rule 102.1. I have, pursuant to Board Rule 102.2, reviewed the employees' showing of interest and have determined that a majority status exists with regard to the proposed unit.

The Board has determined the proposed unit to be appropriate for terms and conditions bargaining and does hereby grant to the Washington Teachers' Union, Local 6, AFL-CIO, exclusive recognition for a unit of:

> "All personnel employed by the District of Columbia Public Schools who are rendering educational services and receive compensation pursuant to the "EG" Schedule, excluding supervisors, management personnel, confidential employees, employees engaged in personnel work other than in purely clerical capacities, employees in the ET bargaining unit, any other personnel currently represented by a labor organization and employees engaged in administering the provisions of Title XVII of the Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act."
