AUTHORIZATION

Pursuant to Sections 502(a) and 1716(b) of the District of Columbia Merit Personnel Act of 1978, (D.C. Code Sections 1-605.2 and 1-618.16) the Public Employee Relations Board (PERB or Board) has determined that the unit found appropriate for non-compensation bargaining as described in the "Certification of Representative" issued by the Board on December 21, 1989, shall also constitute the unit for the purpose of compensation bargaining:

UNIT # 25

Consisting of all non-professional, non-supervisory employees employed by the District of Columbia School of Law who have their compensation set in accordance with the District Service Schedule, and who are currently represented by a labor organization certified as the exclusive bargaining agent for both compensation and non-compensation bargaining by the PERB.
