DECISION AND ORDER

Pursuant to an Order of the Public Employee Relations Board (hereafter, the Board) issued on November 18, 1981, the Washington Teachers' Union (hereafter, WTU) submitted a valid showing of interest representing thirty-three (33) percent of the eligible employees on January 25, 1982.

Based upon its review of the record herein, the Board finds that the employees in the proposed unit share a community of interests and, accordingly, determines that the unit is appropriate as a collective bargaining unit pursuant to D.C. Code Section 1-618.9 (Section 1709 of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978).

ORDER

It is:

ORDERED, that the Washington Teachers' Union, Local 6 and the Public Schools of the District of Columbia are authorized to proceed with the representation process pursuant to D.C. Code Section 1-618.10 (c) (Section 1710(c) of the District of Columbia Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978), and Sections 102.4 - 102.15 of the Interim Rules of the Board.
