DECISION AND ORDER

On November 10, 1983, the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees (AFSCME) filed a Recognition Petition with the District of Columbia Public Employee Relations Board (Board) seeking a determination of appropriate unit and the exclusive right to represent employees of the following proposed unit:

"All full-time security guards employed at the Washington Convention Center, excluding management officials, supervisors, confidential employees, part-time employees any employees engaged in personnel work in other than purely clerical capacities and employees engaged in administering the provisions of Title XVII of the Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978."

The Petition was properly accompanied by a showing of interest meeting the requirements of Section 101.7 of the Interim Rules of the Board. There are no intervenors.

After concluding its investigation and reviewing the entire record, the Board determines the unit described above to be an appropriate unit for collective bargaining concerning the employees' terms and conditions of employment of these employees.

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ORDER

IT IS ORDERED:

An election is authorized pursuant to Section 101 of the Interim Rules of the Board to determine whether these employees wish to be represented by AFSCME or not to be represented in bargaining concerning the terms and conditions of their employment.
