## IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

This case is before us in remand from the Superior Court of the District of Columbia (Superior Court). <u>Clarence Mack, et al.</u> <u>vs. Fraternal Order of Police/Department of Corrections Labor</u> <u>Committee and Calton Butler, Teretha Spain, Jack Rosser, Carissa</u> <u>Pittman, and Helen Barnett</u>, Civil Div., Case No. 0003891-97 (J. Braman) (1998). On January 23, 1998, we issued a Decision and Order in the above-captioned case, i.e., Slip Op. No. 534, granting the Complainants' Motion for Enforcement of our Order in PERB Case No. 97-S-01, Slip Opinion No. 516.
