DECISION AND ORDER

The Complaint in this matter was filed by Mr. William A. Holloman, (hereafter Complainant) on September 22, 1981, charging Washington Teachers' Union, Local 6 (hereafter Union), with committing "...an Unfair Labor Practice under Section 1.347.4(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Code, by failing to exercise its duty of fair representation..." The Complainant alleges that the duty was breached by the Union's failure to assist the Complainant in filing a grievance and appealing his termination.

The Union filed its response to the Complaint on September 29, 1981 denying any violation of its duty of fair representation to the Complainant under Section 1.347.4(b)(1) of the District of Columbia Code.

After investigating the matter and considering the facts, the Board finds that the evidence is insufficient to conclude that the Union violated its duty of fair representation.

ORDER

It is ORDERED that,

The Complaint filed herein is dismissed.
